The heading abstract should be centered left justified. The heading should be written in bold, Times New Roman point 12. The body of the abstract should not exceed 300 words and should be written in one non-indented paragraph (Times New Roman point 12; spacing 1 point between the lines).

The writing style recommended for the abstract is the APA.
